Have you ever eaten insects? The eating of insects has a long history as a part of traditional food culture in some countries. Today, insect-based food is attracting attention. This is because there are many benefits for both health and the environment.

Let's first take a look at the benefits for health. Insects have a large amount of protein, and protein is necessary for a strong body. They are also rich in vitamins and minerals so we can stay healthy. Insect-based food is a good choice for people **7** because it is low in fat. It is lower in calories than beef or pork but it is as nutritious as beef or pork.

Insect-based food also has many environmental benefits. Insects grow quickly and need less food to grow than animals. That means the amount of water and land that is needed will decrease a lot. Many people love to eat beef 8 steaks and hamburgers, but it is actually bad for the environment. Cows produce special gas when they eat food, and the gas is making the earth 9. If people eat less beef and start to eat insects instead, it can be a big help in protecting the earth.

We see many benefits to eating insects but there are also some challenges. Cultural barriers are a big problem. Some people can't easily accept insect-based food. According to a study, about 70% of Americans have negative opinions about it. It seems difficult for people around the world to start eating insect-based food. There is also a problem related to money. When you keep insects and build facilities to produce insect-based food, you need a lot of money. As a result, few people start this kind of business.

The future of insect-based food is bright. The world's population is increasing now. Many people are 10 danger of death because there is not enough food for everyone. Insect-based food can help people who don't have enough to eat. It's also important (2) <u>(remember)</u> that it is good for both the environment and your health. In Japan, you can buy not only traditional insect-based food but also new types. You can now find insect cookies. How about trying (3) some?

Ms. Smith: I read an article in the newspaper about the tourist fee system in Italy. It said that visitors to Venice, a popular place in Italy, will have to pay 5 euros to enter the town on peak days. It is one of the efforts to manage the large amount of traffic. Also, in Japan, too many tourists have visited Yakusugi in Kagoshima, and walked on the tree roots and damaged them. So the local government built a deck to protect the roots. And the number of Mt. Fuji climbers is increasing and it has influenced the environment. So the local government made a rule to limit the number of climbers. Local people have worked hard (1) to protect their own areas.

Megumi : I've never thought about those problems. I always thought that if not only Japanese but also many foreign people visit tourist spots, local people would only benefit. However, (2) it's not true. I'll learn much more about 'overtourism' and try to find possible ways to give happiness to both tourists and local people.
