Slow food is an international movement which was born in Italy in 1986. It is practiced all over the world now. The *slow food* lifestyle is called *slow life*.

When the first McDonald's opened near Piazza~di~Spagna in Rome in 1986, a movement started to stop fast food spreading all over the world. Carlo Petrini, one of the people in this movement, insisted that people should enjoy dishes made with traditional and regional materials. That was the beginning of the slow~food movement. They named their movement "slow food" which was (1) (1) like / 2) against / 3 almost 1) "fast food". It is true that fast food is "fast, cheap, and convenient", but it is mass produced and there are many unclear parts in processing. When we travel to a foreign country, we can always eat the same food with the same taste at fast food restaurants. However, slow~food lovers like to eat different kinds of food in different countries. A >When they are visiting Italy, they want to try Italian food. When they are in China, they want to enjoy Chinese food. Nowadays, more and more people are (2) (1) surprised / 2) excited / 3 interested 1 in slow~food.

Slow food also means the food or dish takes time to be prepared. There are a lot of advantages to *slow food*. First, it is very good for our health. For example, fresh vegetables, fruits and livestock products raised by local farmers are nutritious and rich in vitamins and minerals. Also, people can relax by enjoying and eating food slowly at restaurants. Second, *slow food* protects not only consumers but also local family farms or small-scale organic farming. < **B** >

However, *slow food* has a few negative points to get over in the future. One is that it takes farmers a lot of time to produce crops traditionally by hand without using machines. Another is *slow food* costs a lot because organic farming needs soil that is rich and free of pesticides. It needs farmers who are highly skilled, so it takes more time and more money to produce *slow food*. < \mathbf{C} > Organic ingredients are still expensive, (3) so (1) who 2 is 3 difficult 4 it 5 like 6 to 7 attract 8 young people) fast food. Organic food is not colorful but plain, so they don't post pictures of it on social media so much.
