In the past, when people took a train, many of them were reading books or newspapers. Today, [6], most people are looking at their smartphone. In the last ten years, our daily lives have changed a lot. Smartphones have become very important and we cannot live [7] them. We can contact our friends, look for information, buy things, listen to music, and watch videos. On the other hand, we should try to avoid (2) ( use ) a smartphone too much because it has become a big problem. According to a survey, more than 85 percent of junior high school students in Japan have their own smartphone. Another survey shows that Japanese junior high school students spend about two hours and forty-five minutes a day on their smartphone. Some of them use it for more than five hours. 〈 A 〉

Too much smartphone use can have negative impacts [10] our health. There are three big problems. First, looking [11] the screen [12] a long time is bad for our eyes and causes eye trouble. Second, using smartphones late [13] night reduces our sleeping time. As a result, many students feel sleepy in class and cannot do well. Third, long use of smartphones reduces the time for studying and reading. 〈 B 〉

However, it is not easy to stop using smartphones. Social networking services (SNS) and games are [14]. For example, people wait for new notifications or are asked to log in to games every day. 〈 C 〉

Then, what can we do? There are several things. One thing is to set rules at home. For example, “Don’t use smartphones after nine p.m.” or “No smartphones during eating time.” Another thing is to use screen time management apps. By checking how much time we spend on our smartphone, we can see our habits and try to reduce the time little by little. You can also find other fun activities without smartphones. Sports, music, or reading can give us new ways to have fun and (3) ( ア us / イ less / ウ spend / エ looking / オ help / カ time ) at smartphone screens. 〈 D 〉

There is also the idea of “digital detox.” This means spending time without smartphones or the Internet. For example, you can spend one day of your holidays without a smartphone, or you can try not to use SNS during a trip. Digital detox helps refresh our feelings and bodies, and gives us a chance to think about real communication with people around us. 〈 E 〉

[16], smartphones have made our lives very convenient, but using them too much causes many problems. The important thing is to control smartphone use. [17] By setting rules and trying digital detox, we can enjoy a better life.

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a technology that learns from data, makes decisions, and solves problems. It is very useful for us because it helps us do a variety of things. When we have some questions to solve, we can ask AI and find the answers. (ア), it is said that robots with AI do so many kinds of jobs [23] we may lose our jobs in the future. Today, AI has both [24] points and negative points.

First, at hospitals, AI robots can help doctors and nurses. Doctors can use AI tools and find diseases earlier and treat them, and AI devices can accurately check patients' conditions for nurses. (イ), they can save the lives of patients and reduce the staffs' work. Also a robot animal talks with patients and encourages them.

(ウ), at school, students can learn each subject by using AI systems. If a student can't understand a math question, the system gives more practice on that topic and each student improves their ability at his or her own speed and can enjoy studying.

However, AI also brings (1) challenges. One big concern is job loss. As machines become better at doing many kinds of jobs like data entry and driving a taxi, some people may lose their jobs. Workers must learn new skills to continue their work and do the jobs which can't be done by AI robots, but not everyone can do (2) that.

Another problem is privacy. AI systems collect a large amount of personal data. If this data is stolen, people's personal information will be in danger. It isn't easy to protect the privacy of each person.

AI improves our lives in many situations. At the same time, AI gives us big problems, such as job loss and privacy risks. To use AI effectively, we must make new rules, teach people new skills, and protect personal data. By (3) doing so, we can reduce its negative effects and enjoy our lives with AI.
